

FCCP Eligibility Requirements

Earning the CCP designation is a three-step process which is outlined in the [Process for Earning the FCCP Designation](#). The first part of the process is ensuring eligibility by meeting the following requirements:

Part 1 - Eligibility

Experience Requirements

Any Florida Chamber Executive with a minimum of five (5) years of experience in Chamber management is eligible to apply for the designation. They must be currently employed in a senior-level chamber management position. In order to be considered a senior level manager, the applicant must manage a staff, a budget, programs, and have direct contact with the board.

Executives relocating from other states must have been employed by a Chamber in Florida for a minimum of thirty-six (36) months before submitting an FCCP application.

Professional Development Requirements

FACP emphasizes professional development for the Certified Chamber Professional. To qualify for the essay and ensure that the candidate is exposed to the various aspects of Chamber Management, applicants will be expected to attend Chamber-based programming. By attending programming the candidate will be awarded points as outlined in the [FCCP Application](#). A minimum of 12 points is required to proceed to Step 3 in the process.
